Closing date for all applications is January 15th 2019. To be considered as a Catholic child, proof of baptism must be provided.

Free School Meals: as this is the time of the year when many people review their finances. Can I remind you that your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

Children currently in Reception, Y1 and Y2 currently receive Universal Free School Meals, which needs no application. However, if you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals, please apply as the school will receive extra funding to support your child if you are eligible.
